



Today I want to tell you about some Australian animals. The Australian *continent* is very old and *isolated*, so many unique animals evolved there.

The Kangaroo

The kangaroo is a tall, strong *marsupial*. Kangaroos have long tails and long feet, which they use for jumping and fighting. Some kinds of kangaroo are grey; other kinds have red fur. Baby kangaroos are called joeys. A female kangaroo carries her joey in her *pouch*.

The Drop-Bear

The drop-bear is a large, dangerous cousin of the koala. But while koalas only eat gum leaves, drop-bears eat other animals. Drop-bears hunt by hiding in the high branches of a gum tree, waiting for an animal to walk by, then dropping from the tree onto the animal's head and attacking it with its teeth and claws. Australians sometimes wear big hats to protect themselves from drop-bear attacks.

The Australian Pikachu

The Australian pikachu is actually not related to the Japanese pikachu, but looks very similar. It has yellow fur with dark stripes, pointed ears, and a crooked tail. However, the Australian pikachu is about one hundred centimetres tall and extremely heavy. Its nose is wide and flat, and instead of saying "Pika-pika!" the Australian pikachu says, "Weh."

I hope you have a chance to see these amazing animals someday.






